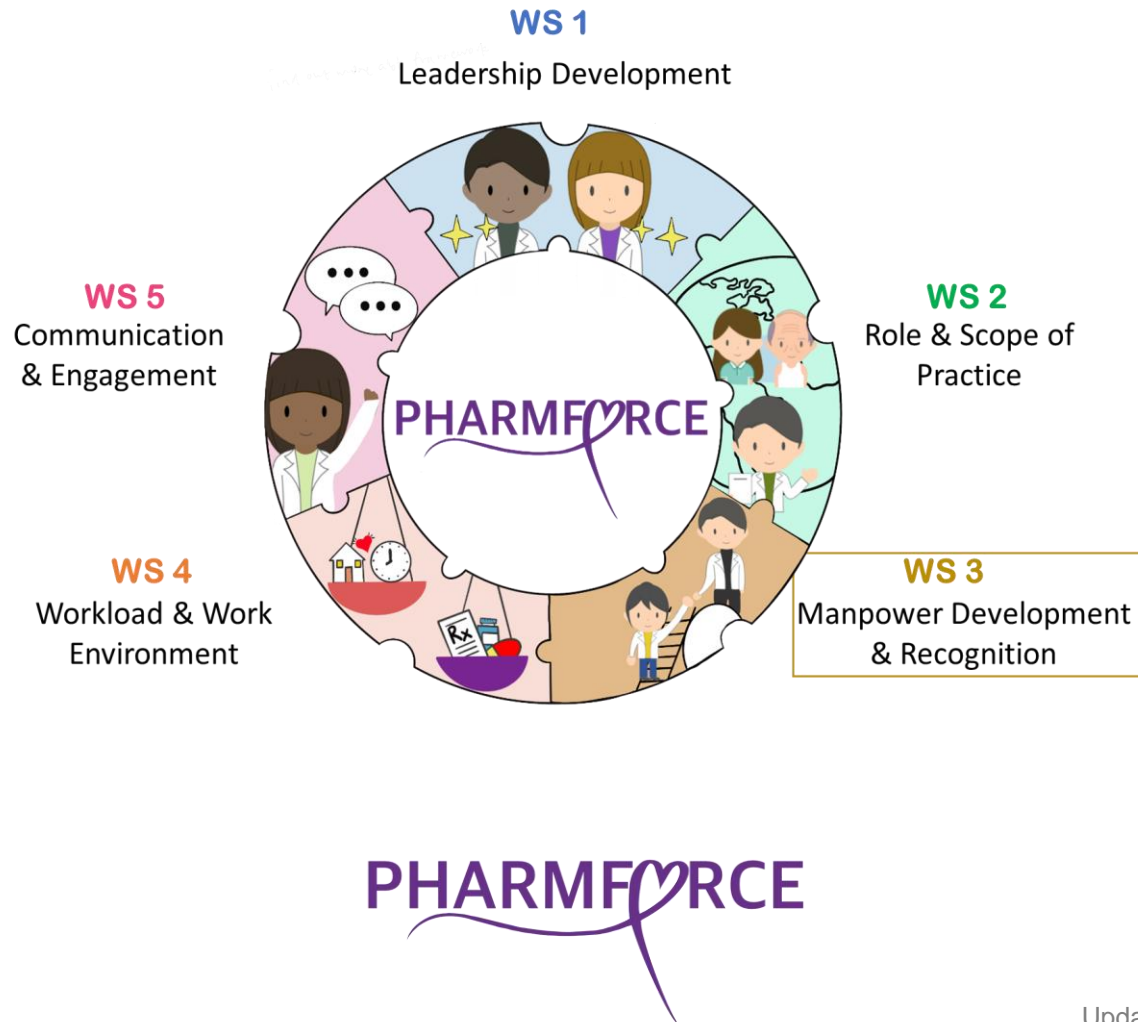
TERMS OF REFERENCE

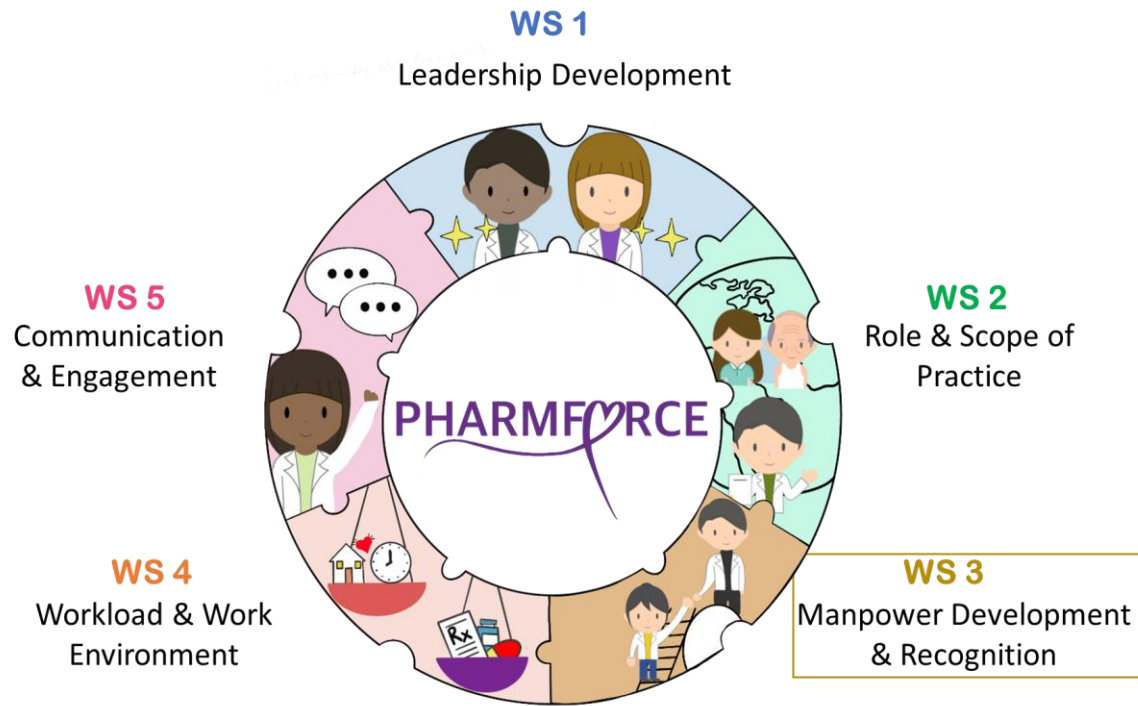

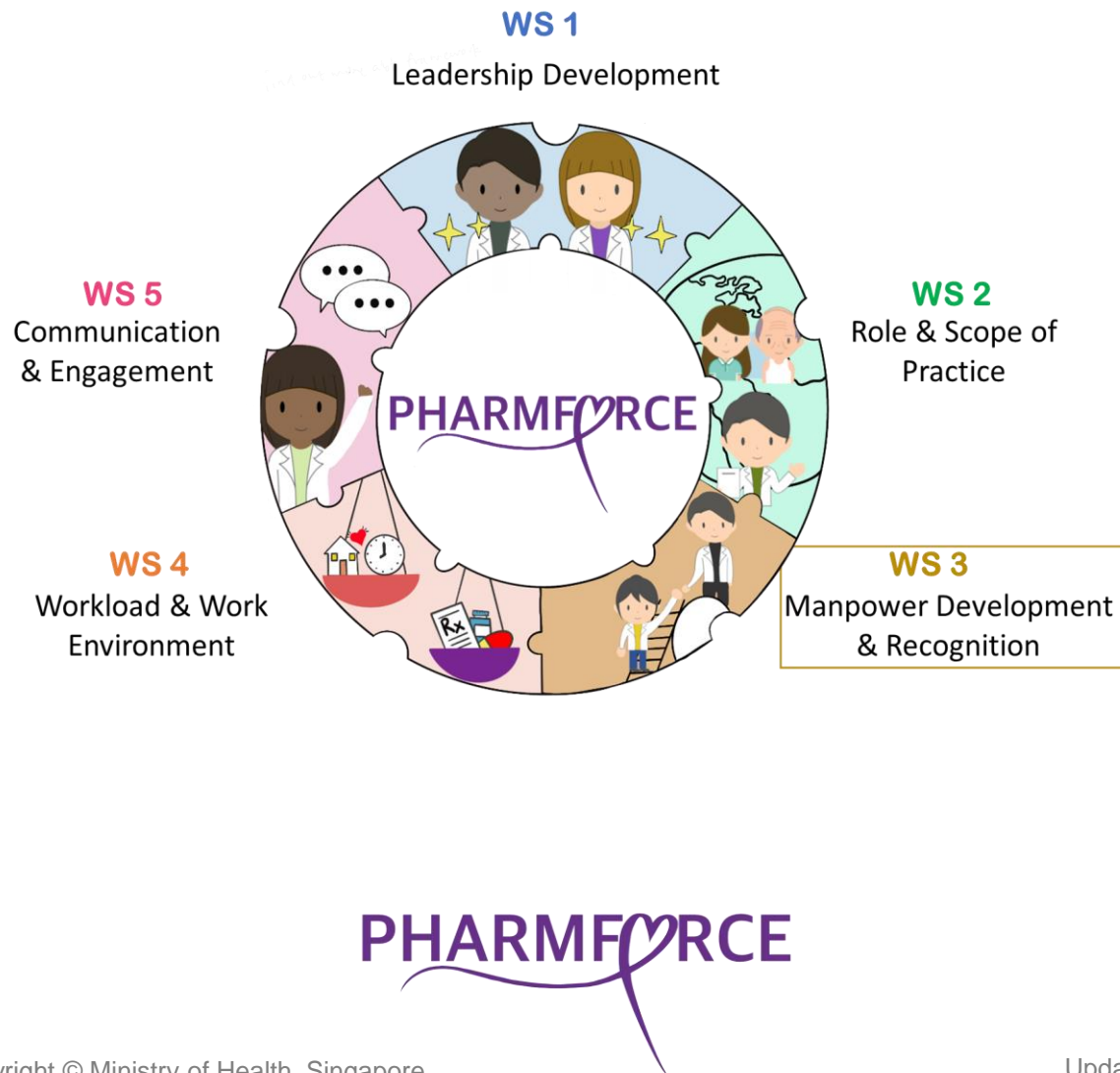

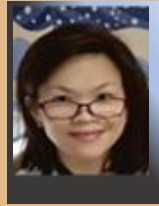
A. Career Pathway and Recognition

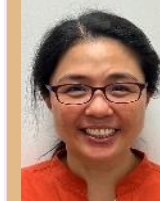
