#### **ADDENDUM**

### On page 141 of full CPG document (and page 27 of the summary booklet):

Infants of women with diabetes who present with clinical signs of hypoglycaemia should have their blood glucose tested and be treated with intravenous dextrose as soon as possible. Close monitoring of blood glucose levels is necessary within the first 48 hours of the baby's life.
